Overbrook residents who use over one thousand gallons per month will see a 2% raise in their water and sewer rates beginning this month. Residents using less than or equal to one thousand gallons per month will not see an increase.

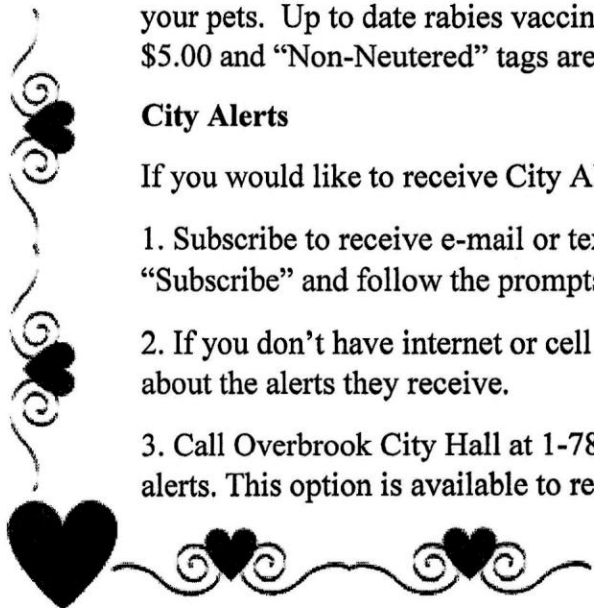
Pet Tags

If you own dogs or cats within the City limits of Overbrook, you are required to annually tag your pets. Up to date rabies vaccine records are needed to purchase a tag. "Neutered" tags are \$5.00 and "Non-Neutered" tags are \$10.00. A late fee will be charged after February.
