Biscuits and Gravy – Come to the Overbrook American Legion for a warm breakfast of biscuits and gravy on Saturday, February 1, 2020 from 7am to 10 am. The last breakfast for this season will be served by donation on March 2, 2018. These breakfasts are a major source of fundraising for the Legion, and all profits go to keep the Post operating and to support community events.

Utility Payments – The fee structure for City Utilities is established by Ordinance #404. The City charges 10% on a balance not paid on or before the 20th of each month. If the 20th falls on a weekend or holiday, the next regular working day shall be the date used.

Delinquent accounts will be shut off if balances are not paid in full, or a hearing request proposing a payment plan is not received on or before 9am on the second Wednesday of each month (Council Meeting Day). A disconnection fee of \$25 and a reconnection fee of \$25 will be applied if services are disconnected.

There is a drop box to the right of City Hall's front door for your convenience. Also, a bank deduction plan is available, or you can pay online by credit card, debit card, or e-check. Look for the link at www.overbrookks.com. Now you can also set your online account up so that you can view your account balance online. Contact City Hall for more information.

Overbrook Police Department - As we close out the first month of the New Year, the Overbrook Police Department has noticed several vehicles in town that are either broken down, have expired tags or both. City Ordinance 353, section 3(a) defines a junked vehicle as incapable of moving under its own power, or in a junked, wrecked or inoperable condition. Basically, if there is a vehicle on your property without current registration, up on jacks or blocks or other supports for 30 days or more it is a violation. If the vehicle is in a garage it is ok. A one time special permit may be obtained through City Hall to extend the time to 90 days, at a cost of \$25.00. Please help in keeping the community clean and safe. 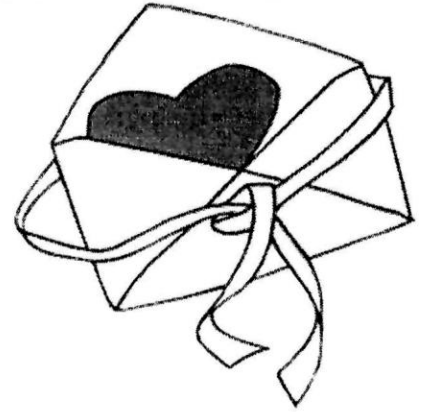
City Alerts -If you would like to receive City Alerts, you have several options to choose from:
