They are like wild animals, Cats are territorial and if you removed them completely new cats just move in. Trap-Neuter-Release. Would like Overbrook to maybe start their own group. Police Chief would like to set up a meeting and get information out and start a group here in Overbrook.</li> <li>E.2 EMC Property Insurance – From Elliott Insurance Darin Johnson, Maria Dressman. Presentation of Insurance Audit. Refer to handouts. Our current insurance broker is Ron Bowls.</li> <li>E.3 Water Project Include RWD #5 Contract Update and Warranty discussion: Wastewater Project Update. We got a response back from Brenda paperwork got lost in the shuffle and they will be sending us the paperwork. We have some warranty items to submit to Carstensen. Feb 17<sup>th</sup> is the date for the Warranty period. Council Member Matt Craig would like to have his meter added to the list to be looked at. Waiting for the signed contract from RW5. We are paying our bill in good faith. We are working on going on a Wetland Cell, property purchase, desludging and we have an engineering estimate.</li> </ul>
H.1F Fired Department	Fire Department building permit fees. Planning and Zoning has signed the building permit. Fire Department is ready to start construction. The city has incurred fees for the sewer evaluation. Charlie Glen was here to discuss the build, the meter installation, etc. Review of what we have now with the fire dept. The City does not charge for water, sewer or trash. How do we handle this when the fire dept moves to their new building? Council would like to leave things as they are but would like to put it onto paper. Some sort of "contract", for the future.
F. Public Comment	Benders are here to discuss their mini pig. They adopted a pig through a legitimate organization of KCPRN. KCPRN called Chief Hollingsworth and he approved housing of a pig. Mrs. Bender shared their love of the pig and their care and devotion to their pig. Their pig is not a "live stock" pig. With the passing of Chief Hollingsworth there is no record of this approval. She would like to normalize pigs as pets. She gave copies of all her paper work for her pig. There is a court date already set for this case. She would like the city to consider rewriting the ordinance, to put something into place about keeping pot belly pigs in town.

G.3 Maintenance Department Action Items	a. Restrooms in old gym. Danny has some numbers for the update. Gas Heaters - \$6,000 for gym, heaters for restrooms \$1,300 each would like to have 4. Toilets \$250 each. Not enough room for 2 in each bathroom. Put in vanities, partitions, \$1448.00 Total \$12,822 without a drop ceiling and electrical. Probably \$15000 to \$20000. We also need to replace the guttering around the building at around \$5800. Trying to make the restrooms ADA compliant is going to be a challenge.
	Maintenance Report – Review of Snow removal, chlorine building complications, using rural water, sewer repairs, drainage by barber shop is fixed and has new concrete.
	Action Item: Would like to purchase a meter that attaches to the fire hydrant. We have companies that would like to purchase bulk water and we would like to have a way to measure this accurately. Danny has priced two meters one at \$2085 and the other is \$2009.
