A call to Casey's General Store regarding the remodeling and opening of their new store has not yet resulted in definite answers. Overbrook Police Car to become a Taxi Cab – City Council sold the old blue police car to a Chicago cab company for use as a taxicab. The company submitted the highest sealed bid as a result of the bid announcement on the Internet. Imagine getting a Cab at O'Hare and it being our old Police car.

Domestic and feral cats running loose in Overbrook remain a concern. If you have a pet cat, please make sure it has a current year city pet tag and can be identified if picked up.

A traffic ticket for failing to stop at an Overbrook Stop sign is \$60, plus court cost of \$75. The same goes for city speed limits. Don't risk a fine . . . drive responsibly!
