CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 19

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 12-744 RELATIVE TO RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS OF PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS AND PROVIDING A SUBSTITUTE PROVISION ON THE SUBJECT OF RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR OVERBROOK CITY PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 241, SECTION 1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Overbrook, Kansas under the authority of Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas elects to and does hereby exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it, the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1222 relative to residence requirements for library board members, being part of an enactment applicable to such city, but not applicable uniformly to all cities and further provides for a substitute provision on the subject of residence requirements for board members for the Overbrook City Planning Commission.

Section 2. Ordinance 241, Section 1, is hereby amended to provide that at least three (3) members appointed to the Overbrook City Planning Commission shall be residents of the City of Overbrook with all members appointed to the Overbrook City Planning Commission being Osage County residents whose permanent home address is within 10 miles of the city limits.

Section 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the City's official newspaper and shall take effect sixty-one days after the final publication, unless a sufficient petition for referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided for in Article 12, Section 5 subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERBROOK, KANSAS, not less than two-thirds of the members elect, voting in favor thereof, this <u>13th of April</u>, 2022.
