	RW#5 Water Contract and Rates: We've been reviewing the contract. **See contract. Questions: Can we become self-sufficient? It's possible. We could look at additional wells, or we could look at Douglas 3. But is this a risk we want to take? Have the wells been cleaned? Yes.
