Note the changes made to tethering animals in the city limits and animals kept on properties where people do not reside. Animal Control reports may be made to the police department at 785-665-7230 or 785-806-9500. — The purpose of Animal Ordinance #408 is to promote harmonious relationships in the interaction between humans and animals by providing regulations that foster a reduced risk to residents from annoyance, intimidation, injury, and health hazards by animals. The ordinance's purpose is also to protect animals from improper use, abuse, neglect, exploitation, inhumane treatment and health hazards.
