Daylight Saving Time - Be sure to grab some extra sleep in the next few days. On Sunday, March 11, we will lose an hour of sleep as we "Spring Forward" our clocks. So, adjust your watches and remember to change the batteries in you smoke detectors too!

Burn Bans – Due to dry weather and/or wind conditions, Osage County Emergency Management may issue county wide burn bans. If you have leaves or branches to burn, you may call City Hall to determine if a burn ban has been issued. You may also sign up for Osage County Emergency Management Alerts at their website www.osageco.org. Click on "County Departments" and "Emergency Management". Do not burn trash or processed lumber! Always be prepared to put out your fire completely if needed.

Burn Permits - As a service to our country residents, applications for Osage County Burn Permits are available at Overbrook City Hall

Police Department: Severe Weather -March is usually when we start to see severe spring weather begin to fire up. Strong thunderstorms can bring dangerous lightning, flash floods and even tornados. March 4 thru 10 is Severe Weather Awareness Week in Kansas with Tuesday, March 6 at 10:00am as the date for the statewide tornado drill. Do you know what to do during a severe storm or tornado? Do you have a plan? Do you know the difference between a tornado watch and a tornado warning? Every year, the National Weather Service holds Tornado Spotter Classes in each county in the state. You DO NOT need to be a spotter to attend these classes. They are free and open to the public, and are a wealth of information to help you before, during and after a severe storm.
