Phase II, Comprehensive Goose Control Plan – This winter, the City of Overbrook implemented Phase I of the Comprehensive Goose Control Plan to reduce the number of resident geese around the City Lake. Phase II of the plan will begin in March to train volunteers on the egg oiling process which reduces the population by decreasing the nesting success. Late March into Early June, trained volunteers will locate nests, mark eggs, and spray them with a light mist of corn oil. And because no young are produced from the oiled eggs the protective aggression of adult geese is eliminated, and the resident population is gradually decreased. WE NEED YOUR HELP. We encourage church groups, supervised youth groups, and other community groups to join in. It will be a chance to spend time outside, use your detective skills to find the nests, enjoy the company of other volunteers, and humanly reduce the goose population.

**Overbrook Police Department** – As we enter March, we are also winding down the school year. There have been some traffic issues around the school I'd like to touch on. First, I'd like to thank all of you who are obeying the school zone speed limit of 20 mph. The traffic is pretty heavy just before and right after school and it seems that there are a few drivers, maybe who are in a rush, trying to cut through the playground area, where the buses are loading and unloading. Oak Street from US 56 to 7<sup>th</sup> is closed from 7:15 am until 3:45 pm during school days. It is never open when the kids are getting on and off the bus. Also, there have been a few stop sign complaints made and the worse is driving around school buses when the red light are flashing and the STOP sign arm is out. This happens mostly away from the school in the outlying areas but it is extremely dangerous and illegal. The police department, along with the school administration, and S.R.O. are working on a new traffic plan for the next school year that would hopefully decrease congestion while increasing safety around the school. 
