Overbrook Police Department - Fall is upon us and that means that critters are becoming more active. Large and small. While smaller animals can cause damage to your vehicle, especially motorcycles, I'm talking about deer. I have noticed more and more deer in the fields when I drive during the daylight hours but, late evening and mornings just before sunrise they seem to be everywhere. Please be extra cautious when driving at night or the early mornings. Our natural first instinct is to slam on the brakes or to swerve to avoid them. Slamming on the brakes, especially when someone is behind you can cause an accident or pileup. Swerving can be even worse. Swerving left can and often does end vary badly if you hit someone head on. Swerving to the right, especially along roads like US 56 East of Overbrook, can be just as bad. There are some pretty deep ditches and drop offs where unless someone saw you go off the road, you might not be found for hours. The best thing to do is, if possible, slow down without slamming the brakes and just go ahead and hit the deer.
