Honor Flight to Washington DC – From the Overbrook American Legion Post #239: ATTENTION all military veterans – An Honor Flight to Washington DC next summer (2025) is now being organized by a group in Lyndon. **Police Department** - The Overbrook Police Department will host Citizen Response to Active Shooter Events (C.R.A.S.E.) on Monday, January 13th, 2025, from 6-8 PM at the Overbrook Community Center. The class will be taught by Master Deputy Troy Squire of the Douglas County Sheriff's Office. The course will cover the history of active shooter events, current trends and what people can do to survive and expect from law enforcement response. This free class is open to anyone and business owners, parents, educators, church members and all citizens are encouraged to attend. Overbrook PD will provide refreshments, and a Q & A will follow the presentation."

**City Hall** – Time to renew your pet tags! Ordinance 408 requires all pets over the age of 6months to have a pet license. Please bring proof of vaccination when applying for a license. Licenses run from Jan1st to Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>. Pet License Form Attached.

**Water Rate** – City council amended Ordinance #415 to raise the 2% January 1, 2025 water and sewer rates to 5%. There was a discussion to clarify that this was for 2025 only. Motion carried 5-0 Council felt that this additional adjustment was needed to meet the cost of the 500,000-gallon monthly comment from RWD #5. (Ord#415; Code 2024)

**Overbrook Maintenance** – Just a reminder, in case of snow, vehicles along the street will need to be moved so the snowplows can get the roads clear.

**Overbrook Parks and Rec-** We would like to welcome Madison Warbritton as our new Parks and Recreation Director. Madison and her husband Brandon are residents of Overbrook and have a small homebased business here. Madison has been studying how our Parks and Rec activities and programs have run in the past and is really looking forward to continuing the great things we have happening here in Overbrook.
