**4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebrations** – Overbrook celebrates Independence Day with a bang! It all starts with the Children's Bike Parade. Children may decorate their bikes and meet at the Old Middle School. Free hot dogs and drinks will be served to the kids. Then from 1-5pm kids and adults swim free at the Overbrook City Pool. Finally come to the City Lake for food, drinks, music and more! Fireworks will begin at approximately10pm. **Overbrook Osage County Fair** - Come to the fair at the Overbrook Fair Grounds during the second week in August from Wednesday through Saturday. Here are a few of the activities scheduled: on Wednesdays, 4-H exhibitors will participate in the dog show and sheep show. On Thursdays, the rabbit show, poultry show, and swine show will take place. Judging of all exhibits will take place after the events. On Fridays, bucket calf show and beef show will take place. Evening events will be scheduled every day starting at 7pm. On Saturdays, there will be pet show, kids contest at soccer field, round robin and kids pedal tractor pull. A parade starts at 5:30pm on Maple (downtown main street) and at 7:15pm the Livestock – Parade of Champions is scheduled.
